Pastor's Letter

Last week I mentioned that Fr. Ron will be leaving for Columbia, MO to help out in a Diocesan parish (does he realize that it is even hotter and more humid down there?). Fr. Ron will be moving down there at the beginning of August. On the weekend of July 30th/31st, we will have a farewell reception for him in appreciation of his eight years of service after each of the Masses. See future bulletins for further details.

With Fr. Ron's move, it means we will be getting a new parochial vicar. Fr. Steve Kuhlmann has been assigned to the parish. Fr. Steve has a background in economics and is a graduate of UW (I didn't get my wish for a Penn State fan). Steve has worked in parishes, Newman Centers (in fact he worked with Melanie Ahern at our Newman Center in Albuquerque at the University of New Mexico) and he has taught at our Dominican high school in Chicago (Fenwick). Fr. Steve is finishing up some commitments at the parish he is at in Columbia, MO and will join us at the beginning of August. We're glad to have Fr. Steve coming on board.

During July, Fr. Ron will be away quite a bit as he prepares to move. Fr. Matt Walsh will help me out with some of the Masses. As a parish, we are always grateful for the help of our fellow Dominicans in the Priory who help out with Masses and confessions when Fr. Ron and/or I have been away. This is one of the occupational hazards of Dominicans in that when we have meetings—they are out of town. So for instance, I was reappointed to the Economic Council of our Province recently as well as being named the Promoter for Social Justice for the Province. This will again require several meetings in Chicago and elsewhere for me during the course of the year.

While on the topic of Dominicans in the Priory, let me give you a brief update about Fr. Joe Fogarty. Fr. Joe usually does the 8:30 AM Mass on Friday and you see him concelebrate at the 7:30 AM Mass on Sunday. You may have also noticed that he has been experiencing greater orthopedic problems over the years. Recently, he has had some falls and other issues. Prompted by concern for his safety, he agreed to go down to Chicago for an assessment to see if he needs a higher level of care than what we can offer in the Priory. As we know more, I'll give you an update. In the mean time, I would just ask that you keep him in your prayers.

Finally, along with our regular weekly financial information, I have also included information on our parish contribution to the Diocese's Annual Catholic Appeal. Overall, the Appeal has already generated well over \$200,000 more in pledges than last year. This is good news for all of the vital outreach services such as Catholic Charities that the Appeal funds. Thanks for your generosity as a parish.
