Classroom Opportunities

Catechist - Classroom Teacher - a person who teachers & shares our faith with children in grades 1-8. I will support each catechists by providing materials, lesson plans, and resources from the RE office.

Co- Catechist - co-teacher - a person who teams up with another catechist, sharing responsibilities and in many cases sharing weekends.

Assistant/aid - a person who assists the lead catechist during sessions. Opportunities would include, helping with projects, monitoring students, participating in small group discussions, or working with individual students. (This is especially needed in the first through third grades)

Substitute - a person who can step in and either teach or co-teach a lesson if the lead catechist is absent. I will provide the substitute with all materials needed to conduct the lesson for the day.

Parent Rep - a person at each grade level who will help the lead teacher coordinate classroom events and service opportunities. Grade _____

Providing Baked Goods - a person who will be willing to provide baked goods for events such as Advent Festivities, Lenten Retreat, Christmas Celebration.

Just Coffee Sales Coordinator - a person who will coordinate the ordering, volunteers, and distribution of "Just Coffee.". This can also be a co-chair opportunity. We plan to sell the coffee 2-3 times this year.

Advent Family Festival - November 27 - a person who can co-chair with a school family, organize treats and activities.

Retreat leader - a person who would like to lead or facilitate a session during our Lenten Retreat for RE families and our First Eucharist Retreat for our RE and school communicants.

Committee Members

RE Advisory Committee Member - a person who is willing to meet with a small group of committee members every other month in order to discuss improvements, plan for events, and develop initiatives. This person may also act as a representative on the Education Commission.

Sacramental Preparation Committee Member - a person who would like to help with the preparation and planning for First Reconciliation and First Eucharist.
